



CODE OF CONDUCT

The Indiana Grizzlies are looking forward to the 2024 Youth Football Season! To provide the best experience for each player, there are rules and regulations that must be followed during Grizzly practices, events, and games, including but not limited to: team training, preseason, and season. The Indiana Grizzlies will not tolerate any verbal or physical abuse of our coaches, players, spectators, or referees from any player, parent, or spectator. If a parent, guardian, or spectator violates the Code of Conduct or becomes a distraction to the experience, the coach(es) will have the right and authority to suspend, expel, or ban violator(s) from current and future Grizzly practices, games, or events. If a player violates the Code of Conduct or becomes a distraction to the experience, the coach(es) will have the right and authority to suspend, expel, or ban player(s) from current and future Grizzly practices, games, or events, or provide another form of discipline, at their discretion.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Parent, Guardian and/or Spectator

1. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials, and staff at all Grizzly practices, events, and games.
2. I will place the emotional, psychological, and physical well-being of my child, and any other child on the team, ahead of any personal desires I may have.
3. I will respect the coaches' right to coach. I will offer no interference whatsoever during practice or games. Should I have a concern, I will wait for the appropriate time in which to consult with the coach(es). Any game or practice issues concerning playing time, positioning or management will not be addressed by the coaching staff during a practice or game.
4. I will, along with any guest of mine, refrain from any vulgar, lewd, or obscene language or gestures while participating in or watching any Grizzly events.
5. I will treat other players, coaches, parents, officials, and spectators with respect, regardless of race, sex, religion, or ability.
6. I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, parents, officials, and spectators with respect, regardless of race, sex, religion, or ability.
7. I will support all coaches and other staff working with my child, to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
8. I understand that only coaches, registered players, and approved volunteers are allowed on the field during all practices, games, and events. Parents or guardians are encouraged to attend all practices, games, and events, but must observe from an area designated for spectators.
9. I understand that playing time per player may differ due to attendance, understanding of the game, safety concerns, ability, etc. Playing time is not guaranteed.
10. I will provide transportation to and from all practices, games, and events. If traveling out of town, I will be responsible for my child's expenses.
11. The use of alcohol or drugs during any Grizzly practice, game, or event is strictly prohibited.

Player

1. I will always demonstrate good sportsmanship and respect for other teammates, players, parents, spectators, coaches, volunteers, and officials.
2. I will do my best to listen and learn from all coaches and staff.
3. I understand that attendance is important and will do my best to attend scheduled practices, games, and events.
4. I will not use profanity or taunt others.
5. I will never purposely engage in an act that may physically harm another.
6. I will always do my best to practice and play the game of football within the rules.
